a £50 penalty will be incurred if a horse declared at that date does NOT run**

- FIRST RACE** **A HANDICAP HURDLE, about TWO MILES,**
2.30 pm for three years old and up
£28 to enter,
Prize Money £2,300 - Winner £1,460 (Penalty value), Second £525, Third £315.
Weights: Lowest ... 9st 3lb; Highest ... 11st 10lb.
Penalties (not cumulative): a winner on or after 14th August of a hurdle race...7lb.
- SECOND RACE** **A HANDICAP, about FIVE FURLONGS 100 YDS,**
3.05 pm for three year olds and up
£28 to enter,
Prize Money £2,000 - Winner £1,270 (Penalty value), Second £460, Third £270.
Weights: Lowest ... 8st 5lb; Highest ... 10st 12lb.
Penalties (not cumulative): a winner on or after 14th August of a race ... 7lb.
- THIRD RACE** **THE CLARENDON, A HANDICAP, about ONE & A HALF MILES,**
3.40 pm (Horses which have NOT been in training in the Channel Islands from 31st July 2012, and
which in the opinion of the Handicapper are rated over 75, are NOT eligible.)
for three year olds & up
£35 to enter,
Prize Money £3,000 - Winner £1,900 (Penalty Value), Second £685, Third £415.
Weights: Lowest ... 8st 5lb; Highest ... 10st 12lb.
Penalties (not cumulative): a winner on or after 14th August of a race ... 7lb.
- FOURTH RACE** **A HANDICAP (up to 55), about ONE & A QUARTER MILES**
4.15 pm **which in the opinion of the Handicapper are rated up to 55, and which have been in**
training in the Channel Islands from 1st June 2012 and which at starting have NOT won a
flat race, hurdle race or National Hunt flat race since 1st January 2012
for three year olds & up,
£28 to enter,
Prize Money £2,300 - Winner £1,460 (Penalty value), Second £525, Third £315.
Weights: Lowest ... 8st 5lb; Highest ... 10st 12lb.
- FIFTH RACE** **A HANDICAP, about ONE MILE 100 YDS,**
4.50 pm for three year olds and up
£28 to enter,
Prize Money £2,300 - Winner £1,460 (Penalty value), Second £525, Third £315.
Weights: Lowest ... 8st 5lb; Highest ... 10st 12lb.
Penalties (not cumulative): a winner on or after 14th August of a race ... 7lb.
