Before the running of the first race Mr. J.S.O. Arthur requested that **GREEK THEATRE** running in the opener be allowed to do one circuit of the parade ring early and then be allowed to go to post. The Stewards after a short debate and noting the good behaviour last time out allowed the request. The Stewards Secretary arranged for the Judge to be at the top of the chute & also arranged that the commentator kept a discreet silence as the horse came on to the track.

At approximately 1345 The Clerk of the Course and the Race Club Secretary brought to the attention of the Stewards that one of the Medical Officers had left the course to attend an emergency incident. This might have delayed the start of racing; however after some minutes it became clear that the emergency the Medical Officer was going to attend was not as serious as first thought and that he was returning to the course.

Before the running of the fourth race Mr. J Mercier requested that **CRONKYVODDY** be led in at the start. Following a conversation with the Starter who has the authority to sanction such requests permission was given. Mr. J.S.O. Arthur requested that **ATHANIA** also running in the fourth be led to the start, the Stewards granted this request.

Following the running of the Fourth Race the Stewards interviewed Kylie Manser as to why **UNIFORM RUBY** bolted before the start of the race. The jockey reported that the horse had been surprised by an event at the start, quite possibly kicked by another runner and after that "it was not going to stop". She praised the Starter for letting the tape go quickly so she could have a free run. The Stewards did not have time to interview the trainer but requested that she appear before them after the running of the last.

Following the running of the last race the Stewards interviewed Mrs. A. Malzard about the behaviour of **UNIFORM RUBY**. The trainer reported that the horse had indeed been kicked by another mount and this had caused the horse to bolt. The Stewards noted this explanation.

The Stewards requested that the Stewards Secretary make sure that all the trainers are reminded they are due in the parade ring in good time as there had been some slippage in start times due to horses being late into the Parade Ring.
