The Stewards Secretary noted that he had yet to receive a Vets Certificate for **ROCK DIAMOND**, a non-runner at the previous meeting from the trainer Mr. B. Powell. The trainer will now be written to before the matter is escalated.

Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **REBEL WOMAN** running in the fifth race requested that the horse be allowed to go post early. Mrs. A. Malzard, trainer of **JACKPOT** running in the fifth race requested that the horse be allowed to be led in at the start if required. Mr. S.J.O. Arthur trainer of **ATHANIA** requested running in the fifth have someone with the horse at the start. The Stewards considered all the requests, however as per Rules the Starter duly granted permissions, with a reminder that any horse that requires to be led in is started from the second row.

The Stewards immediately called an enquiry after the running of the first race into possible interference at the two furlong marker and after the final hurdle. Having heard their evidence and viewed a recording of the race they found that **THE BAY BANDIT**, placed second, ridden by Mr. G. Tumelty, had not interfered with **IF I HAD HIM**, placed first, ridden by Mr. M. Batchelor. The result was therefore allowed to stand and no further action was taken.

Following the running of the fourth race the Stewards interviewed the trainer Mrs. A. Corson as to the refusal of **FINE THE WORLD** to start. The trainer had not yet had a chance to speak to the owner about the future of the horse, however the Stewards Secretary reported that the owner had informed the Senior Steward of the CIR&HC, Mr. I Ozanne that the horse will now be retired. This being the case no further action is required, nonetheless if the horse is to run again it will be subject to an enquiry.
