GOING: GOOD TO SOFT

Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **REBEL WOMAN** and **ATHANIA**, running in the fifth race requested that the horses be allowed to go post early and if needed, be led in. The Stewards considered the request and duly granted it. The Stewards Secretary informed the Starter.

Before the running of the second race **KERSIVAY**, trained by Mrs. A. Malzard ridden by Jemma Marshall together with **CHESTER'SLITTLE GEM**, trained by Mrs. A. Corson, ridden by Phil Collington having not obeyed the recall flag and completed the course were withdrawn by the Stewards under Rule 21 xi (e).

Immediately after the running of the second race the Stewards called an enquiry into the false start and whether or not **KERSIVAY**, trained by Mrs. A. Malzard ridden by Jemma Marshall together with **CHESTER'SLITTLE GEM**, trained by Mrs. A. Corson, ridden by Phil Collington had not obeyed the recall flag. Following a review of the tape and hearing from both jockeys it was concluded that both had breached Rule 21 xi (e) and were duly fined £25 each.

Following the running of the second race the Clerk of the Course informed the Stewards Secretary that the going had changed and was now officially: **GOOD, GOOD to SOFT in PLACES.**

On the final bend of the fifth race, Jenny Ferguson riding **REBEL WOMAN**; trained by Mrs. A. Corson, was unseated, medical assistance was immediately called for and once the stewards were satisfied that everything possible was being done to help her, an enquiry began, to try to establish the cause. Viewing of the tape revealed that there had been a coming together between **PAS D'ACTION**, trained by Mrs. A. Malzard, ridden by Tom Garner and **REBEL WOMAN**. Most of the relevant parties had left the course and the Stewards were unable to interview everyone they wished to, although several people were spoken to. Jenny Ferguson was taken to hospital by St. John's Ambulance and the Stewards were not able to interview her. For that reason the Stewards are unable to reach a conclusion at this time
