As the owner of **MR OPULENCE**, Mr Smith stood down for the first race.

Prior to the start of racing Mr Karl Kukk, the trainer of **HERBALIST** in the first race, requested permission for the horse to be mounted in the chute. Mrs Angie Corson, the trainer of **REBEL WOMAN** and **ATHANIA** in the fourth race requested that **REBEL WOMAN** be first out of the parade ring and be mounted on the course. Mrs Corson also requested that **ATHANIA** be accompanied to the start. The Stewards duly granted these requested.

The medical team examined Harry Cruickshank, the jockey of **POMANDER**, after unseating in the first race and passed him fit to ride for the remainder of the meeting.

Following the running of the fourth race, the Stewards interviewed Mrs Angie Corson, the trainer of **ATHANIA**, as to **ATHANIA**'s reluctance to race. Mrs Corson said that there was nothing that would encourage **ATHANIA** to start and horse was now likely to be retired from racing but that she could not confirm this absolutely. Having considered the matter the Stewards noted **ATHANIA**'s chequered history at the start and warned that that should **ATHANIA** return to the racecourse and refuse to race again, then they would have no choice but to refer the matter to the Stewards of the CIRHC.

Following the running of the fifth race the Steward's interviewed Mr J. Moon, the trainer of **INFORMALITY**, as to the horse's poor performance. Mr Moon said that the horse stumbled in the back straight when already out of contention and the jockey saw no point in giving her a hard time. The Steward's noted the explanation.
