Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **DIAMOND PENNY**, running in the third, along with **REBEL WOMAN**, running in the last, requested that her horses be allowed to go post early and be led in, if so required. The Stewards considered the requests and duly granted them. Mr. K. Kuk, trainer of **STEELY**, running in the fourth requested that his horse be allowed to wear a hood whilst in the parade ring and go to post the long way. As per rules the Stewards allowed the horse to wear the hood but only in the parade ring. Mrs. C. Gilbert reported that she was unable to find a suitable jockey for **MAJORMAXIMUS** and therefore had no option but to withdraw it. The Stewards noted the explanation but had no choice in issuing her a fine of £50. The riders in the fourth race requested permission to wear black armbands as a mark of respect to the late trainer Mr J Mercier, the Stewards had no hesitation in granting the request.

The Stewards enquired into the behaviour of **REACH OUT**, trained by Mrs A. Malzard, ridden by Mr. F. Tett at the start and its eventual withdrawal. The trainers representative Mr. A. Malzard reported that the horse had become agitated in the Parade Ring and then arriving at the start 'just planted itself' refusing to race. This was unusual behaviour for the gelding. The Stewards duly noted this explanation and took no further action.
