The Stewards enquired into usage of the whip by Mr M. Quinlan riding **STEELY**, trained by Mr K. Kuki'k. They noted the jockey's explanation that the horse was hanging right and he was trying to correct the intended line, however following a review of the tape they fined the jockey £50.

The Stewards asked Mr M Batchelor rider of **ROSSETTI**, trained by Mrs A. Malzard about its poor performance. No further action was deemed necessary.

Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE JERSEY'S FINEST ESTABLISHMENTS "GLORY BEE" HANDICAP

The Stewards reminded the trainer Mrs A. Corson that all three of her horses were late in the Parade Ring for which she apologised.

Race 5 – 4.50pm. THE HSBC HANDICAP MILE

The Stewards immediately called an Enquiry into possible interference between **FIRST CAT**, trained by Mr K. Kukik, placed third, ridden by Mr P. Prince and **LUCIFERS SHADOW**, trained by Mrs C. Gilbert, placed second, ridden by Ms A. Mills. Following a review of the tape and some deliberation, the Stewards were satisfied that places should remain unaltered and the result was allowed to stand.
