***Prior to racing :***

Mr K. Kukk, trainer of **FIRST CAT**, running in the second, requested permission for the horse to 'go the long way round' to the start.

Mrs A. Corson, trainer of **REBEL WOMAN**, running in the fourth, requested permission to go to post early and mount in the chute or on course if required to do so.

The Stewards considered the requests and duly granted permission. The Stewards Secretary informed the Starter of the requests, who also confirmed his consent.

**Race 1 – 2.30pm. THE LADBROKES BETSTATION HANDICAP HURDLE**

The Stewards spoke to the jockey Miss L Gardner, daughter of the owner Miss J Edgar as to the improvement in form of **JAZZIE LADY**, trained by Mrs S. Gardner, the winner of the race. The jockey reported that the horse had been in their yard for 3 weeks and was therefore a bit of an unknown quantity, though clearly an exciting prospect. The Stewards noted the explanation and took no further action.

**Race 2 – 3.05pm. THE LADBROKES BET LIVE IN PLAY HANDICAP**

**Race 3 – 3.40pm. THE COUTTS HANDICAP**

The Stewards held an enquiry into the use of the whip by Mr Philip Prince, the rider of **BROWN VELVET**, trained by Mr K Kukk, from about the three furlong marker. Having heard evidence and viewed the recording of the race, they found the jockey just within rules and warned him as to his future whip use.

**Race 4 – 4.15pm. THE LADBROKES LADIES DAY HANDICAP**

No Stewards Enquiry.

The Stewards interviewed the jockey Mr Philip Prince, as to his continued disrespect for the Stewards Secretary and Stewards of the day; the trainer Mr K Kukk who he is booked to ride for, was also present. Mr Prince was left in no doubt that his continued insolence will result in a hefty fine as well as suspension, on this occasion however, no fine would be levied.

**Race 5 – 4.50pm. THE LADBROKES BEST ODDS GUARANTEED HANDICAP**

The Stewards enquired into possible interference at the two furlong marker between **BOWL IMPERIOR**, unplaced, ridden by Mr M. Batchelor, trained by Mrs A. Malzard and **RIVER DU NORD**, placed 1st, ridden by Miss J. Marshall, trained by Mrs S. Gardner. Having heard evidence from Mr M. Batchelor and viewed the recording of the race, they found the interference to be accidental and were satisfied that it did not involve a riding offence.

There being no further enquiries the Stewards were dismissed at 5.10pm
